## English 2

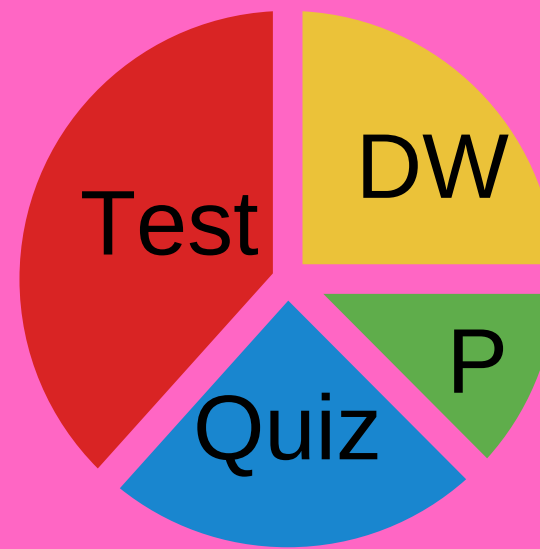
