Grading Policies:

- **Tests:** Students will test at the end of each unit (generally two units per 6 weeks). Students MUST show their work for FULL CREDIT. Students will have the chance to fix any mistakes in class after being graded. **Students will have one class period to finish the test**.
- **Quizzes:** At least 2 quizzes will be given each 6 weeks. Work must be shown to receive FULL CREDIT. There will also be a Folder grade & an Outstanding Math Guide (OMG) grade at the end of the six weeks. This should be an easy A, and help keep you organized!
- **Assignments:** These will vary and should be turned into the tray. Students MUST show their work to receive FULL CREDIT.

CORRECTIONS:

Any quiz or test of any grade will be able to be corrected for $\frac{1}{2}$ points back as long as they follow the Correction Form. The student will have ONLY 1 week to turn in their corrections.

LATE WORK POLICY: (see attached for more info)

1 day late = max grade of 95

2 days late = max grade of 90

5 days late WILL RESULT in a zero (unless made up in MWM)

MakE-up WORK:
