	Mitigation Strategy	LEA Response
✓	Universal and Correct Wearing of Masks	In accordance with Executive Order (GA-34), Iowa Park CISD will make mask wearing optional for all individuals on campuses.
✓	Physical Distancing	Campuses will arrange seating to maximize physical distancing as space allows.
✓	Handwashing and Respiratory Etiquette	Students and staff are encouraged to wash their hands as necessary. Hand sanitizing stations remain in classrooms and in common areas at all campuses. Students are encouraged to practice respiratory etiquette to prevent the spread of viruses.
✓	Cleaning and Maintaining Healthy Facilities Including Improving Ventilation	Classroom desks and common area surfaces are cleaned after each use. High touch surfaces such as door knobs are cleaned and sanitized throughout the day. Restrooms are sanitized throughout the day. When feasible, windows and doors may be left open for ventilation.
✓	Contact Tracing in Combination with Isolation and Quarantine, in Collaboration with the State and Local Health Districts	Contact tracing is done in conjunction with the local health department. Isolation and quarantines are used following current guidance from the CDC, State or Texas, and local health department.
✓	Diagnostic and Screening Testing	Testing is encouraged when a person has been identified as a close contact or is exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19.

✓	Efforts to Provide Vaccinations to School Communities	Vaccination clinics were held for staff in the Spring of 2021. All staff were invited to attend. Future vaccination opportunities will be communicated to staff.
✓	Accommodations for Children with Disabilities with Respect to Health and Safety Policies	All necessary medical and safety precautions will be followed. In addition to adhering to the district's health and safety policies for all children. ARD committees will make decisions for individual students with disabilities.
✓	Coordination with State and Local Health Officials	The district will communicate often with the local health department and will follow state regulations.
√	Addressing Students' Academic Needs, and Students' and Staff Social, Emotional, Mental Health and Other Needs Including Student Health and Food Services	The LEA will ensure continuity of services, including but not limited to services to address students' academic needs and students' and staff social, emotional, mental health and other needs, which may include student health and food services.
