1.2	The district will continue to focus on College, Career, and Military Readiness (CCMR) for all students: offering additional programs of study, Texas College Bridge - to have students college ready, adding approved Industry Based Certifications (IBC) to every program of study, administrate TSIA to all sophomore and juniors.		
1.3	The district will consider elective opportunities in areas such as careers, languages, technology, and STEM.		
1.4	The district will replace interactive boards with interactive tvs and slates at all campuses as needed.		
1.5	The district will provide professional development on using district provided curriculum for data driven and engaging instruction.		
1.6	The district will provide opportunities for general education teachers to obtain professional development in serving special education students.		
1.7	The district will replace computers in computer labs as needed.		
1.8	The district will provide professional development on improving math instruction in the classroom for tier 1 students.		
1.9	The district will provide a campus media center within the library at the high school so that students and teachers can present more interactive and hands-on lessons and projects.		
1.10	The district will consider adding 3D printers, poster printers, new document cameras and other technology resources at all campuses.		
1.11	The district will send teachers to enriching conferences in the areas of technology, CTE, and instruction.

2.3	The district will continue to implement a behavioral/emotional support system for both students and staff utilizing TCHATT		
	and Region 9 services.		
2.4	The district will consider adding lighting in darker parking lots and areas on all campuses.		
2.5	The district will explore installing enclosed fencing, covered walkways between main building and A-building and Ag		
2.5	building at high school.		
2.6	The district will consider providing devices for classroom doors in the case of a lockdown.		
2.7	The district will continue to improve internet speed and capability.		
2.8	The district will work to enhance the reunification process and procedures for each campus: Skylerts, location, parent pickup,		
2.0	and job assignments.		
2.9	The district will provide a means of communication between campuses in the case of an intruder or lockdown.		
2.10	The district will continue to add additional cameras across the district as needed.		
2.11	The district will provide trauma kits on the campus, buses, and school vehicles in case of traumatic emergencies.		
2.12	The district will streamline staff training in the areas of drug use, cyber security, threat assessment, dating violence, and		
2.12	social media.		
2.13	The district will consider adding additional vape detectors as needed.

3.1	The district will upgrade parking lots at the middle school as well as the administration building.
3.2	The district will consider replacing the turf on the football field.
3.3	The district will consider updating the science labs at the high school.
3.4	The district will have central heat and air installed in the old gym at the middle school.
3.5	The district will consider fencing and equipment upgrades on playgrounds at the elementary campuses.
3.6	The district will consider replacing the greenhouse at the high school.
3.7	The district will consider replacing the floors in the elementary gyms.
3.8	The district will continue to update classroom interiors at each campus as needed from flooring, fresh texture and paint, and
	seating.
3.9	The district will investigate the need for additional custodial staff due to increased campus size at the middle school.
3.10	The district will explore updating the seating in the high school gymnasium on the home and visitor sides.
3.11	The district will consider adding more ventilation in welding shop and auto shop.
3.12	The district will consider providing wheelchair accessible and inclusive/adaptive areas on the playgrounds for special needs
	students.
3.13	The district will repair north circle drive at Kidwell to address water drainage.
3.14	The district will consider resurfacing blacktop areas where students play.
3.15	The district will consider building a new transportation barn with at least three bays.
3.16	The district will consider metal fencing on the south side of the bus barn.
3.17	The district will consider a gravel/paved parking lot on the north side of Kidwell.
3.18	The district will consider adding fencing in front of the show barn.
3.19	The district will consider moving the ag farm to new the new facility.
3.20	The district will consider adding additional parking at the show barn.
3.21	The district will consider looking at a more modern cafeteria and seating area along with providing alternative food options.
3.22	The district will consider providing a shower area with a washer and dryer for students when needed at the elementary
3.44	campuses.
3.23	The district will explore adding an indoor multipurpose practice facility.

4.6	The district will continue addressing staff shortages with substitutes and bus drivers.		
4.7	The district will consider bringing in motivational speakers to support, encourage, and provide best practices that can be		
	incorporated in the classroom.
