Overview:

Students in Digital Art and Animation will learn how to create digital art and animations. Students will use Adobe PhotoShop the first semester for digital art. A few examples of projects we will make in class are: Light Sabers, Avatars, Magazine Cover, Optical Illusion, and how to digitally apply makeup. During the second semester we will start working with Adobe Flash and learn how to make animations. A few examples of projects that we will be working on are: adding animations to previously recorded videos and movies, adding a strobe light effect to animations, and we will learn how to rotoscope. Rotoscope is a type of animation where you annotate over a video and transform it into a cartoon.

Classroom Rules:

- There will be NO food or drinks allowed in the classroom. A bottle of water will be allowed, but must be kept on the floor. No bottles of water will be allowed on the tables.
- Chewing gum: I see it or hear it, it goes in the trash.
- Tardiness: If you are not in my class when the bell rings, you are tardy. If you are outside the classroom door when the bell rings, you are tardy. We will abide by the tardy policy that is located in your student handbook.
