## **Student Tardy Information (Per Six Week Period)**

- 1<sup>st</sup> Student tardy= warning from teacher
  2<sup>nd</sup> Student tardy= assign D-Hall with teacher before or after school (15 minutes).
  3<sup>rd</sup> Student tardy= assign D-Hall with teacher before or after school (15 minutes) and call the parent. The teacher must document the parent contact so the student can be placed in ISS on the 4<sup>th</sup> tardy.
  4<sup>th</sup> Student tardy= the student will be placed in ISS for 1 day. The student will be placed in ISS the next day. Report the 4<sup>th</sup> tardy to Mr. McFadden.
  - When a student does not show up for D-Hall the student has become non-compliant. Report the student to Mr. McFadden. Use good judgment in assigning D-Hall to a student. Take in account the many variables our students have no control over. In this situation common sense should prevail.
  - Up to 10 minutes after the tardy bell rings a student is considered tardy. After 10 minutes the student will need to procure an admit slip from the office.
  - Use the tardy documentation sheet to keep up with student tardies. Have the students print their name and initial with the date.
